- Inform Channel Twelve to get exposure on the media.
- Form a historical committee to inform members of their heritage.
- Help maintain an Irish heritage booth at the International Food Festival in September 1992.
- Get involved in bringing Irish children to Richmond.
- Establish an information bank with people who have been to Ireland to pass on information to others.
- Establish a fund raising committee
- Establish a newsletter

Entertainment was provided by Kevin Donleavy (Irish traditional music, past and present). Mr. Donleavy also listed several area places where Irish music is presented.
